

Over the weekend, Hurricane Harvey made landfall on the Gulf Coast of Texas. The hurricane was unprecedented, with catastrophic flooding and up to 50 inches of rain in some areas.

Thousands of people in the affected areas are now displaced. FEMA is estimating that over 30,000 may need shelter and some 450,000 may qualify for federal flood victim assistance. These numbers are likely to increase as the aftermath of the storm continues to evolve and more educated estimates of the extent of the damage can be made. Many organizations and volunteer groups have stepped up to provide much needed relief to the Gulf Coast area. FJC has compiled a list of organizations that are working to assist the relief effort in Texas. If you are interested, we are happy to assist you in making a grant.
